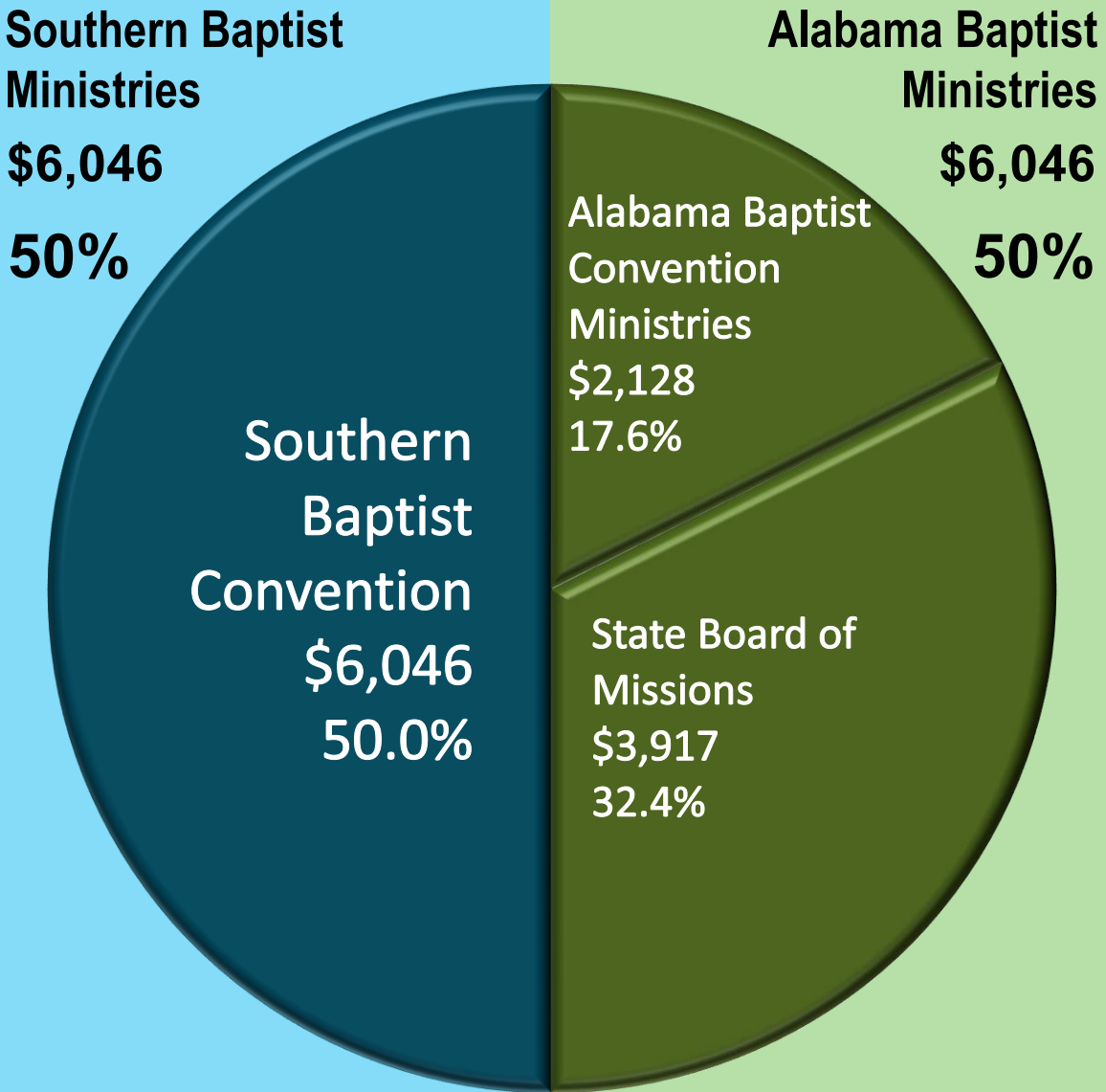

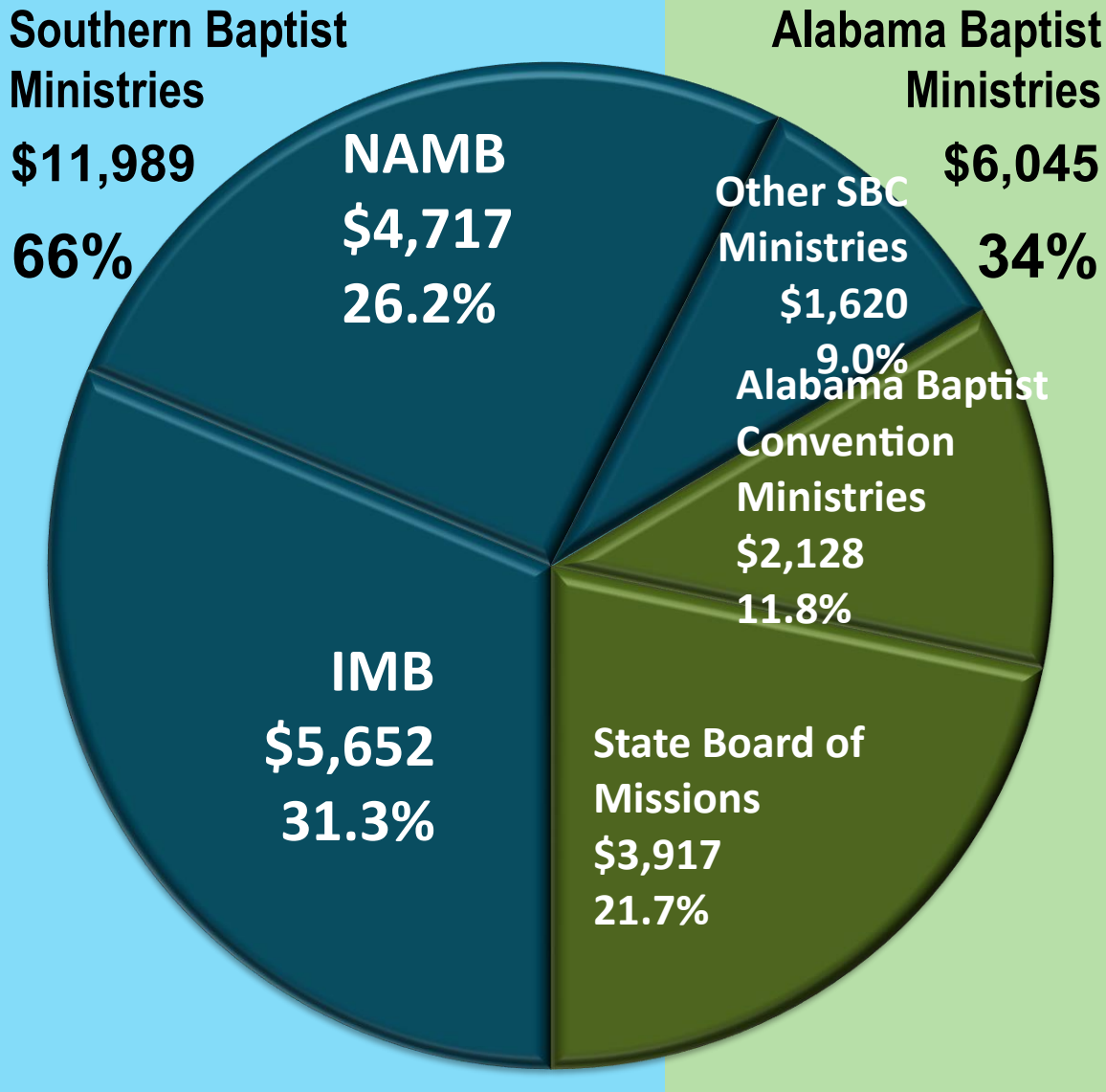

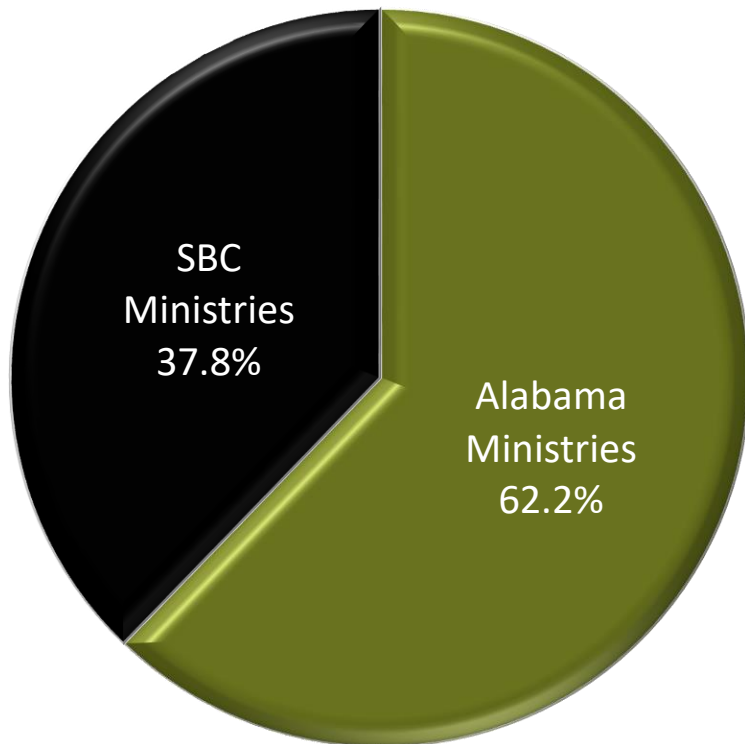

- ALCAP receives 100% of the ALCAP Offering.

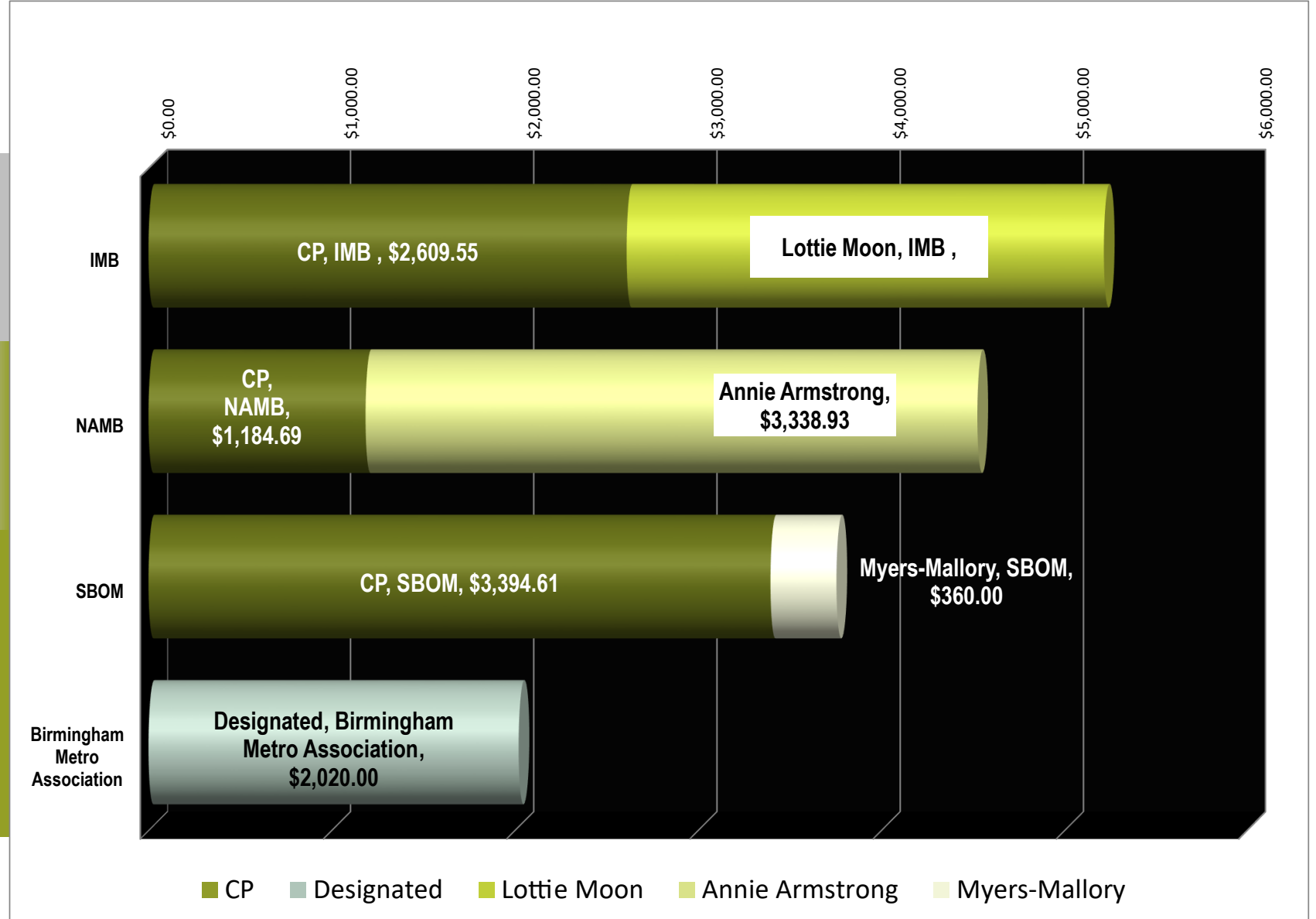
