### **Day 1 - January 15, 2025**

**John 1** - The Word Became Flesh - As you sit with God today, focus your prayer time on possible new creations for SCBC.

### **Day 2 - January 16, 2025**

**John 2** - Jesus Turns Water to Wine - Just as Jesus changed the water into wine, meditate today on how He is changing your life AND how you can help to change our church.

### **Day 3 - January 17, 2025**

**John 3** - Nicodemus and Jesus' Teaching on New Birth - Nicodemus had a position in the Jewish council and yet he missed the true meaning of truth that Jesus shared with him. As you read today's scripture, ask the Spirit to reveal to you the truth you need to hear.

## **Day 4 - January 18, 2025**

**John 4** - The Woman at the Well - Like the woman at the well, what are you needing from God to "fill you up"? Listen to the Spirit and receive what God has for you. Like the woman at the well – He knows your deepest needs and He longs to provide for you.

## **Day 5 - January 19, 2025**

**John 5** - Jesus Heals a Lame Man - This chapter opens with a question to a paralyzed man, "Do you want to get well?" The man didn't answer the question. He gave an excuse. How often does God ask things of us and we just give excuses. As you read through John 5 today, meditate on who Jesus truly is and ask Him to help you fully trust Him to work in your life.

## **Day 6 - January 20, 2025**

**John 6** - Jesus Feeds the Five Thousand - This chapter opens with the feeding of 5,000. One of the people that gets overlooked is the boy who offered his lunch. He didn't have much but what he had he gave freely to be used for others. As you pray today ask God how you can be used to glorify Him.

**John 7** - Jesus at the Feast of Tabernacles - As streams of water quench our physical thirst, pray that our church may be refreshed by the Spirit's filling, so that we may be one with each other.

## **Day 50 - March 5, 2025 LENT BEGINS**

### **Ephesians 1 - Spiritual Blessings in Christ**

*Theme for Lent: The richness of God's grace in our lives. Begin by reflecting on the blessings of salvation that Christ offers.*

## **Day 51 - March 6, 2025**

### **Ephesians 2 - Made Alive in Christ**

*Reflect on the contrast between our deadness in sin and being made alive in Christ through His sacrifice.*

**Lenten Reflection:** Consider how you've been spiritually reborn through Christ's death and resurrection, and commit to a deeper life of repentance and gratitude.

## **Day 52 - March 7, 2025**

### **Ephesians 3 - The Mystery of Christ Revealed**

*Theme for Lent: The mystery of God's plan to save all people through Jesus. Lent is a time to meditate on the unfolding of God's redemptive work.*

## **Day 53 - March 8, 2025**

### **Ephesians 4 - Unity in the Body of Christ**

*Theme for Lent: During this season of reflection and fasting, consider how we are called to unity in Christ, as the church body is united through the cross.*

## **Day 54 - March 9, 2025**

### **Ephesians 5 - Walk in Love**

*Theme for Lent: Christ's sacrificial love for us calls us to love others selflessly. In this Lenten season, reflect on how to embody this love in your relationships.*

## **Day 55 - March 10, 2025**

### **Ephesians 6 - The Armor of God**

*Theme for Lent: Put on the armor of God during Lent as we face the temptations of this world and seek to grow in holiness and strength in Christ.*

## **Day 56 - March 11, 2025**

### **Psalms 1 - The Way of the Righteous and the Wicked**

*Lenten Reflection: Reflect on the difference between a life rooted in God's Word and the empty pursuit of worldly desires. Are there areas of your life where you need to turn back to God?*

## **Day 57 - March 12, 2025**

### **Psalms 23 - The Lord is My Shepherd**

*Lenten Reflection: Consider the comfort of God's presence and guidance through the wilderness of Lent. Jesus is our Good Shepherd who leads us into eternal life.*

## **Day 58 - March 13, 2025**

### **Psalms 27 - The Lord is My Light and My Salvation**

*Lenten Reflection: In this season of repentance and fasting, consider how the Lord is your light in dark times. Trust Him with your fears, struggles, and desires for growth.*

## **Day 59 - March 14, 2025**

### **Psalms 42 - As the Deer Pants for Water**

*Lenten Reflection: During Lent, we long for God's presence as a thirsty deer longs for water. Reflect on your own hunger and thirst for righteousness and spiritual renewal.*

## **Day 60 - March 15, 2025**

**Psalm 51 - A Prayer of Repentance**

*Lenten Reflection: This psalm is a prayer of confession and repentance, recognizing God's mercy and forgiveness. As Lent comes to a close, offer your heart in repentance and humility, seeking God's cleansing and restoration.*
